- a. Blood drive met its targets.
- b. Open House was one with the most attendance.
- c. Report on the 4 pillars
- <u>Academics</u>: Honor Roll (over 30% of students have over 80%). Academic enrichment (newsletter: will be coming with Poetry Slam, Coffee House, Christmas Week); Youth Caravan "Inside the mind of a teen" for Sec. 3 school project of former students who tested their final project in Psychology
- Athletics: invite kids to come and watch the home game that is coming; training room is open from Monday and Thursday; Hiking club with 13 kids that go out every 2 weeks.
- <u>Arts</u>: workshops started in November twice a week (Japanese Art Techniques, Watercolor, etc.); Performing Arts Concentration did their first presentation at Holland; Coffee House is upcoming on December 11 from 7pm to 9pm (50 students performing) music, dance and improv performances.

7. Update on Measures & Budget

- Mr Thomson goes through his Measures follow-up presentation.
- 467 784 \$ budget for Measures. 118 782 \$ is for the Seuil minimal de services pour les écoles and is mainly for hiring specialists (expenses are mainly HR) and currently, budget will be spent when the psychologist comes; 136 466\$ is for extra-curricular. Ecole Inspiration supports local school initiatives. FLS Measure is disappointing. Jordan's Principle (Federal funding for First Nation students) is 124 000\$, resources just got hired in a context where we are struggling for hire.

- a. Transportation Committee: no meeting was held.
- b. CQSB Parents' Committee: Robotics presentation was made to board, who is trying to start a Committee. Testing for lead in the school water supply was discussed. Plumbing is a city issue. Approx. 50 positions are open throughout the school board. In some schools, Principal and Vice-Principal are going back to teaching to mitigate lack of teachers. Bill 40 is at the Parliament (Commission Parlementaire). EPCA was very badly quoted by the Minister who cited, completely out of context, that "English parents agree to that". Next PC meeting is scheduled for February.
